Notes from the President: Hello Everyone!!!



By the time you receive this newsletter I will have surpassed 180 days in bed and off my feet. I had a setback in that the final layers of skin on my feet lack the blood flow to heal since most of it is calloused. This was also compounded with having a rough week in the hyperbaric chamber because of 3 bad sessions. I am experiencing blurred vision, ringing in the ears, and disorientation. I have completed 38 of the 60 scheduled sessions and as of this writing they have suspended my treatments until I have a medical consultation. Keep me in your prayers.

We are in a holding pattern on our picnic pavilion. As you all know the 20'x30' structure is ready for shingles. We are revising our application to ABC Roofing to see if we qualify for a donation of the shingles. In the mean time we still have to build a wall around the pavilion and backfill it in order to make it level.

We have submitted a proposal to place a camera and a live feed to our website at the fish ladder located on the Bridgeport side of the Schuylkill River at the Norristown Dam. The camera will be used to record how many Atlantic Shad are using the ladder. We now have most of the necessary paperwork to move forward with the process at the Norristown Fish Ladder. We needed to add the method of access to the ladder and all activities covered under our insurance to the application. Once the Norristown Farm Park receives the completed application they will turn over the keys and paperwork to get the fish ladder up and running. We can now go shopping for a 100% water proof Go-Pro camera, a tripod and dish to enable transmission of the live feed to our website. We will be ready for the spring of 2019 shad run which usually happens between March 15th to April 30th. We will tour the Fairmount Dam fish ladder to learn some cleaning techniques and maintenance procedures. This will be a real learning experience and will provide important data to understand the shad migration up the Schuylkill River. We would like to thank the Norristown Farm Park, Montgomery County Commissioners and State Senator Damon Leach who helped to finalize the paperwork to officially open the Norristown Fish Ladder in Bridgeport.

Our 21st Annual Memorial Trout Derby was held on the weekend of April 28th and 29th. We had a nice turnout for the 3 Thursday night work parties which averaged 17 members for each day. We also had 31 members to help out on set up day the 27th. As for the derby we had 46 members and several community service volunteers to man the different areas. We had a nice crowd on Saturday and a sparse one on Sunday since it was very windy and chilly. We raised \$8000.00 dollars for the event which pays for the operation of the Cooperative Trout Nursery and our children's programs. A note was sent to the Times Herald to thank everyone for all their support especially the Sponsors for their donations of money, goods and services, gift certificates, and food and drinks. I would also like to say **THANK YOU** to all of our members, their families and children, and the community service volunteers for an outstanding job on this year's derby.
