A quick update from our 31<sup>st</sup> annual Stony Creek Clean Up held on Saturday March 25<sup>th</sup>. We had a nice turn out which included 88 volunteers. The donated 20 yard dumpster was only filled half way. Four tires were the only large items. The only down side to the day was the fact that the Times Herald did not publish a thank you from the club. It's the only way for us to say thank you to so many groups, business people, clubs, troops and volunteers. So a heartfelt **Thank You** to all who helped to make the clean up a success.

Our 20<sup>th</sup> Annual Trout Derby on the Stony Creek had amazing volunteer support to make it a great success. Here are the numbers of volunteers; work party #1 had 21, work party #2 had 21 and #3 had 16. We provided food and cold drinks for all who helped out. Set up day, Friday April 28<sup>th</sup>, there were 35 volunteers. A group of 8 community service workers did the bulk of the heavy duty tasks. We were grateful to have them help us out. We supplied hoagies, potato chips and cold drinks for all volunteers. We had 46 volunteers for each of the two days of the derby.

On Friday evening I was under the canopy on top of a picnic table as a very nasty thunder and lightning storm struck. The creek went into a flash flood and washed 3 of our handicapped ramps downstream. Luckily one of the dams we constructed caught the ramps.

On Saturday morning the stream was high and muddy and by 9:30AM a lot of fishermen were leaving empty handed, however, they returned by late afternoon. Saturday we had over 250 cars and trucks in the field and on Sunday we had 150. It was hot on Saturday but we had a nice crowd and a lot cooler on Sunday. The fishing was better on Sunday and a lot of big fish were showing up on stringers. The take down went very well and in 3 hours we had all of our tents, signs etc. packed up and put away.

We had two neat banners made up for the derby. One was a welcome to everyone and another was a listing of all our sponsors; very impressive indeed. I was also very encouraged by the number of volunteers who came out to make it possible to pull off this major club event. Thank You to all who made our derby another success!

We would like to thank Toll Brothers for their donation of lumber, plywood and all roofing materials which will be used to construct a 30' x 30' picnic pavilion next to the club house. In addition we also would like to thank PECO for their donation of telephone poles to serve as corner posts for the pavilion.

We hope to see some new faces at our next meeting on <u>Tuesday</u>, June 13, 2017 at the Norristown Maennor-Chor Club, 920 West Haws Avenue, Norristown, PA. - Must fish between Flat Rock Dam (Gladwyne) and Black Rock Dam (Phoenixville).
- Boat access at River Front Park, Norristown (Haws Avenue), Flat Rock Dam (Gladwyne) or Black Rock Dam (Phoenixville).
- No boats launched at Betzwood in Valley Forge Park No Bank Fishing in Park (Park Closes at Dusk).
- At weigh-in all fish must be alive. Only live fish will be accepted for entry
- Longest fish wins. If a tie the heaviest will determine the winner.
- Prizes can be picked up at the Stony Creek Anglers Nursery.
